## *Art: It's Elementary!*

The Stark Museum of Art is pleased to announce its fourth annual elementary art exhibition, *ART: It's Elementary!* The exhibition will feature original works of art from Region 5 and Calcasieu Parish elementary students in Kindergarten – 3<sup>rd</sup> grades. The exhibition will be held January 14 – March 11, 2023 in the Community Art Gallery at the Stark Museum of Art and online at starkmuseum.org. Participants must be in K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade in a private, public, or homeschool in Region 5.

### **Important Dates and Information:**

- Registration forms will be available beginning **August 16, 2022** at starkmuseum.org.
- **Orange County elementary schools may submit a maximum of 8 entries for the exhibition. Schools outside of Orange County may submit up to 4 entries with a teacher from their campus attending the ART: It's Elementary! Teacher Workshop on Friday, November 4, 2022.** It is up to each school to select which works of art are submitted.
- **All artwork must be delivered by a school representative to the Stark Museum of Art by Friday, December 16, 2022 no later than 5:00 p.m.** Late entries will not be accepted. All of the entries for an individual campus should be delivered at the same time.
- **An Artists' Recognition Ceremony for students, families, and teachers will be held on Saturday, January 21, 2023. The Artists' Recognition Ceremony will be in conjunction with museum's Family Day event.**
- Orange County public and private school artwork will be delivered to schools by March 24, 2023. All other artwork must be picked up from the Museum between March 22 and 25, 2022 during regular business hours. Artwork that is not picked up will be deemed donated and will be discarded or used for other purposes as deemed appropriate by the Stark Museum.

### **Requirements for Submission:**

1. **Artist must be currently enrolled in K-3<sup>rd</sup> grades in a public, private, or homeschool in Orange County, Region 5, TX, or Calcasieu Parish, LA.** *Submitting Artists outside of Orange County are only permitted if a teacher from their school participates in the ART: It's Elementary Teacher Workshop on Friday, November 4, 2022.*
2. **Artwork must be two-dimensional, and hand-rendered.**
3. **Artwork must be no smaller than 8" x 10" and no larger than 9" x 12".**
4. **Submissions should be on a flat, 2-dimensional surface, no deeper than ¼" inch. Please no entries on stretched canvas.**
5. Matted and/or framed submissions will not be accepted and returned immediately to the teacher and/or campus submitting the work.
6. Artwork must be appropriate for an audience of all ages, including children. Excessively violent themes, offensive, crude, or derogatory subjects or designs are not permitted. Stark Museum, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to reject or remove any submission that fails to meet these standards.
7. Artwork must have a typed label with artist name, grade level, title of artwork, and school on the back of his/her submission.
8. **Only one original artwork per artist may be submitted.**
9. **Artwork will be matted for the exhibition using acid-free tape. Artwork featured in the exhibition will be returned matted.**
10. Completed registration form, with **BOTH** student and parent (or guardian) signatures, **MUST** accompany the artwork, **regardless of student age.**
